Profile Of Foundation

Skate & Beyond Foundation's main goals is to give access to skateboarding, to connect people from different backgrounds, to strengthen personal and social skills of the local communities and to give them a new perspective to their personal future.

To realize this, the Foundation offer free skate workshops during which the mentors accompanied the skaters in the process of learning skateboard or other disciplines. The Foundations also offers vocational trainings to the skaters to improve on their financial status and social well-being. All equipments and materials are free of charge during the Foundation's activities to ensure that everyone can join and learn freely without any barriers. We welcome all people from all ages and all levels and also organize special activities for girls and women.

Having observed the impact of skateboarding through the regular sessions we organize in the public spaces, we know skateboarding is a powerful tool for empowerment, growth and connection among the youth of northern Uganda. It is substantial for physical health, helpful for mental health and crucial to community development. Skateboarding is a unique path for positive change in a developing community. Therefore the Foundation long term goal is to sustain these opportunities for the Gulu youth by meeting the demand for a safe outdoor space to play, explore and grow by constructing the first skate park in Gulu.


Vision

Highlights In 2023



SKATE OUTREACH

We reached out to 2 new communities in Lira and Kitgum and provide them with some skate workshops and materials.

We also visited two orphanage, one in Gulu and one in Kabale.

2 VOCATIONAL TRAINING

We organized a bakery training for our skaters, they have gained basics bakery skills and management skills to improve on their financial status and social well-being.



FIRST SKATE EVENT OF NORTHERN UGANDA

We hosted 2 skateboard events & competitions in Northern Uganda (first of its kind!)





GIRLS SESSION

We offered weekly sessions for girls, for them to feel safe in a space mainly occupied by boys.

ACQUISITION OF THE SKATEPARK FUNDS

We have established a legal charity: "help building the first skate park in northern Uganda" to start off the discourse, design and funding of the skatepark.



Our activities in numbers

For 2023 we have achieved the following:

- We offered a minimum of 2 skate sessions per week.
- We organized more than 150 skate sessions in Gulu, around 50 for kids and 15 for girls only.
- We grew the community to **350 participants**, that joined at least one skate session.
- We have a team of around 20 regular girls skaters
- We have acquired **4 new pairs of roller-skates** & have introduce roller-skate's sessions.
- We recieved around 15 new skateboards and longboards
- We acquired 4 new obstacles.
- Our skaters range from 5 to 37 years old.
- We reached out to 100+ orphans
- We gave out 75 pairs of skate shoes for our end of year gathering
- We organized 2 vocational trainings.
- We were representing the Skate & Beyond Foundation at 4 community/public events
- We did 2 **documentary** on our activities
- We were present on 1 national radio
- We did **5 street rides to advertise** in town for different stakeholders and one was for the national TV.



Milestones of 2023

- We registered the Skate & Beyond Foundation as an NGO to support the several Skateboard Communities in Northern Uganda
- We identified the land and raised the funds to invest in the first phase of the construction of the first ever skatepark of northern Uganda. The land is located in Gulu city, Layibi-kal East.
- We globally gain in visibility at a local, national and international level by positioning ourselves as an actor of change, by strengthening our partnerships with local authorities, by partnering with 2 more international stakeholders and by creating our website.
